



FAQ'S FOR JOURNEY'S RE-ENTRY STRATEGY

DOES JOURNEY HAVE A RE-ENTRY PLAN: Absolutely! Aside from online services, our re-entry strategy consist of four phases as follows: Phase 1: Outdoor services in the church parking lot; Phase 2: Indoor services with restrictions; Phase 3: Relaxing of some restrictions; Phase 4: Celebrate when we can safely return to enjoying fellowship meals together.

WHERE WILL WE MEET DURING PHASES 2 & 3? The Worship Center with overflow rooms available across both buildings (East & West).

WHAT TIME? 10:00 A.M. To be evaluated regularly; A time change w/two services will occur when needed.

HOW WILL WE GATHER: Socially distanced seating will be provided.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT? Uplifting worship; relevant, practical, convicting preaching; fervent prayer; and the presence of God. Families are encouraged to worship together during phase 2 since there will be no nursery or childcare provided. *JourneyKids* will be suspended through phase 2. Words to the songs projected onto monitors. A projector and screen will be utilized in the West auditorium.

WILL THE SERVICE BE BROADCAST? Yes! Should you choose to remain at home, you may connect with us through Journey Facebook live. The service will also be broadcast on FM radio station 102.1 for short range reception for those who wish to remain in their vehicle on the church parking lot. Recordings of our service are being posted on our website at www.journeybn.com.

ARE THERE GUIDELINES FOR SOCIAL DISTANCING? Yes! During Phase 2 greeters will be wearing masks at our main entryways and opening doors in order to limit the number of persons touching door handles. Spacing six feet and the use of masks are encouraged for all persons while inside the buildings at all times as per CDC guidelines. While on the church premises we ask that you gather in clusters with those from your own household, or those who rode to church with you. Our volunteers will be clearly marked with tags. They will be available to answer questions while they serve as greeters, hosts, AV operators, as well as monitors and security for our parking lot and overflow rooms.

Please do not approach other people, shake hands, or hug, unless you clearly have their permission to do so. During phase 2 you will be asked whether you want to wear a red or a green sticker as you enter the buildings. A red sticker indicates, "I'm social distancing, please respect that and keep your distance." A green sticker indicates, "you have permission to approach me."

When we celebrate communion, the bread and juice will be distributed in self-contained prepackaged containers by volunteers wearing gloves and masks. Our restrooms will be sanitized for your use. Please thoroughly wash your hands before touching any surfaces after using the restroom. Hand sanitizer and wipes will be available in restrooms and countertops in both buildings.

CAN I RECEIVE PERSONAL PRAYER? Absolutely! Upon request. Gloves and masks will be expected during phase 2.

HOW CAN I GIVE MY TITHES & OFFERINGS? A table will be set-up in both the East and West buildings where you can leave your contributions. You may also send your contributions through the mail to Journey Church, 1320 East College Avenue, Normal, IL 61761, drop it off during office hours, during the week (check with Sara Peters for availability at 309-452-3359, or, give online: www.journeybn.com, by setting up an account on the REALM community and following the links. WILL COFFEE BE AVAILABLE? No. You will need to bring your own during phase 2.

WHAT OTHER MINISTRY OR ACTIVITY WILL JOURNEY CHURCH BE ENGAGED IN DURING PHASES 2 & 3 OF THE JOURENY RE-OPENING PLAN? The church office will be open M-F. Call ahead 309-452-3359. The Food Pantry and *Redeeming Manna* ministry will be operating. Groups ≤ 50 will be permitted. The youth will be gathering with parental permission. Small groups will be encouraged. Our Elders and staff may permit other ministry activities as conditions warrant under the leadership of the Holy Spirit.

NOTE: Some of the preceding restrictions will be lifted at the discretion of our elders, staff, and trustees as we move into phase 3 of the re-entry strategy. Please note that we may also move back to a previous phase, or even skip a phase, in either direction as conditions warrant.
